

Dear Parent/Guardian,

This year, we will be looking at some people in the Bible. These are people who made a difference in the lives of those around them. Some of the things that they did affect us even now.

The first person we are going to learn about is Abraham.

For you child ages 3-6, a bible is included the packet. This is a beginner's bible.

Please read together pages 39-45.

Here are some wondering questions for you:

- I wonder if you ever been given instructions to go somewhere?
- I wonder what it felt like for Abraham to leave his home?
- I wonder what you think of the promises God made?
- Abraham trusts God. I wonder how it feels to trust someone you cannot see?

In the packet is a blindfold. A fun game is for one person to put on the blindfold and the other person tell the blindfolded person how to cross a room without walking into things. You can take turns and you can add obstacles.

Abraham is considered the Father of all the Jewish people, all the Christian people, and all the Muslim people.

There is a fun song that you can sing together. The lyrics are simple:
Father Abraham Had many sons. Many sons had Father
Abraham. I am one of them and so are you So let's all praise
the Lord!

At the end of the verse, a body part is shouted out and then you start moving that part around, adding on as you go.
Right Arm! Left Arm! Right Foot! Left Foot! Chin Up! Turn around! Sit Down!
