The next symbol we are looking at is the Dove.

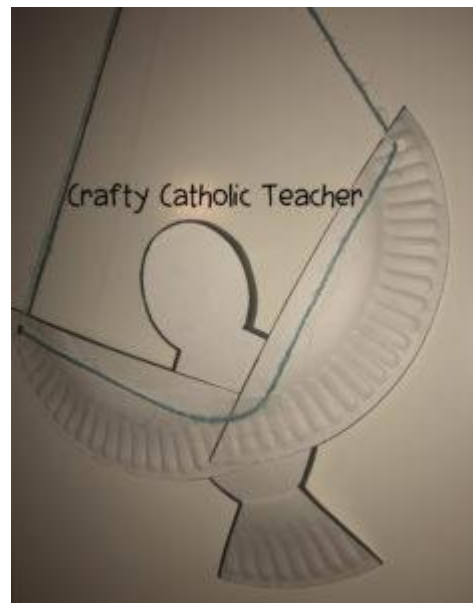
The dove is seen as a symbol of the Holy Spirit. Starting on p. 303 of the Beginner's Bible is the story of John baptizing Jesus. Please read it together.

- I wonder how John felt seeing Jesus.
- I wonder how Jesus felt being baptized.
- I wonder how everyone felt seeing the dove.
- I wonder why the Holy Spirit took the form of a dove.
- I wonder what you think about when you see a dove.

In the take-home packet is a paper plate and direction for making a dove as well as a clear sheet for making your own stain glass window using markers and a fun maze and coloring page.

- Start with a regular, cheap paper plate.
- Draw two lines to make the wings.
- In the middle section, draw the body and tail of the dove. [
- **[Tip: Draw the lines you need to cut on the back of the paper plate. That way, when you flip it over, the marker lines won't show] (See Picture).**
- Cut on your lines, and then assemble like a dove with one of the big wings on each side.
- Glue the wings on the back of the dove.
- Draw on some simple feet, a beak, and 2 eyes with markers.
- [Optional]: Punch a hole on the top of both wings. Tie the string through it so you can hang it up. Tape the string closest to the dove to the back (See Picture).



Color in your own stain glass picture!
Print out on clear paper. Use markers to color in.
