Skip ahead and read Chapter 22 verses 12 and 13. The same words are repeated that are in Chapter 1 verse 8. Think about the beginnings and endings in your life. What happens when something ends?

Who do you think is in charge of beginnings and endings?

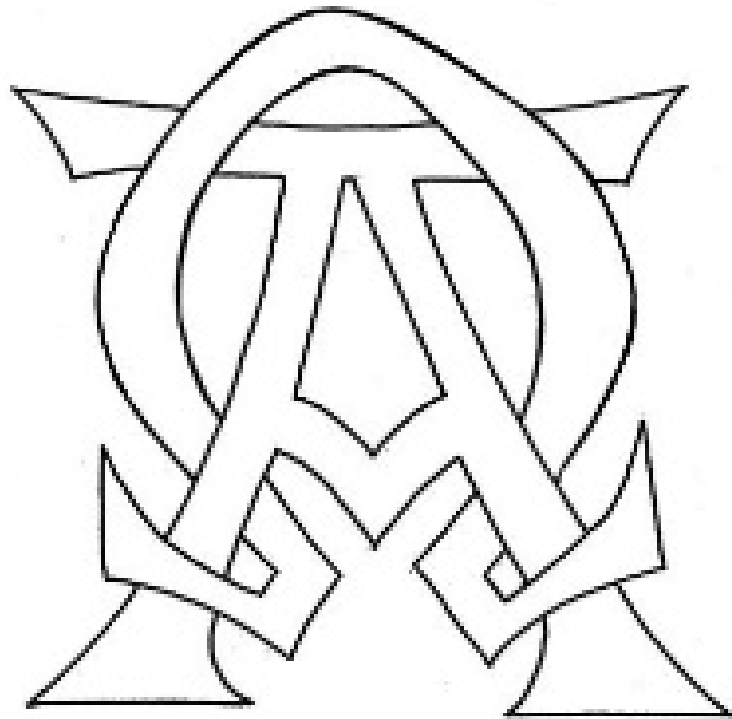
We don't always know what comes next when one phase of our life ends. Ask someone older than you about a time in their life when they were unsure of what would happen next. How did they deal with the uncertainty?

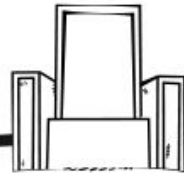

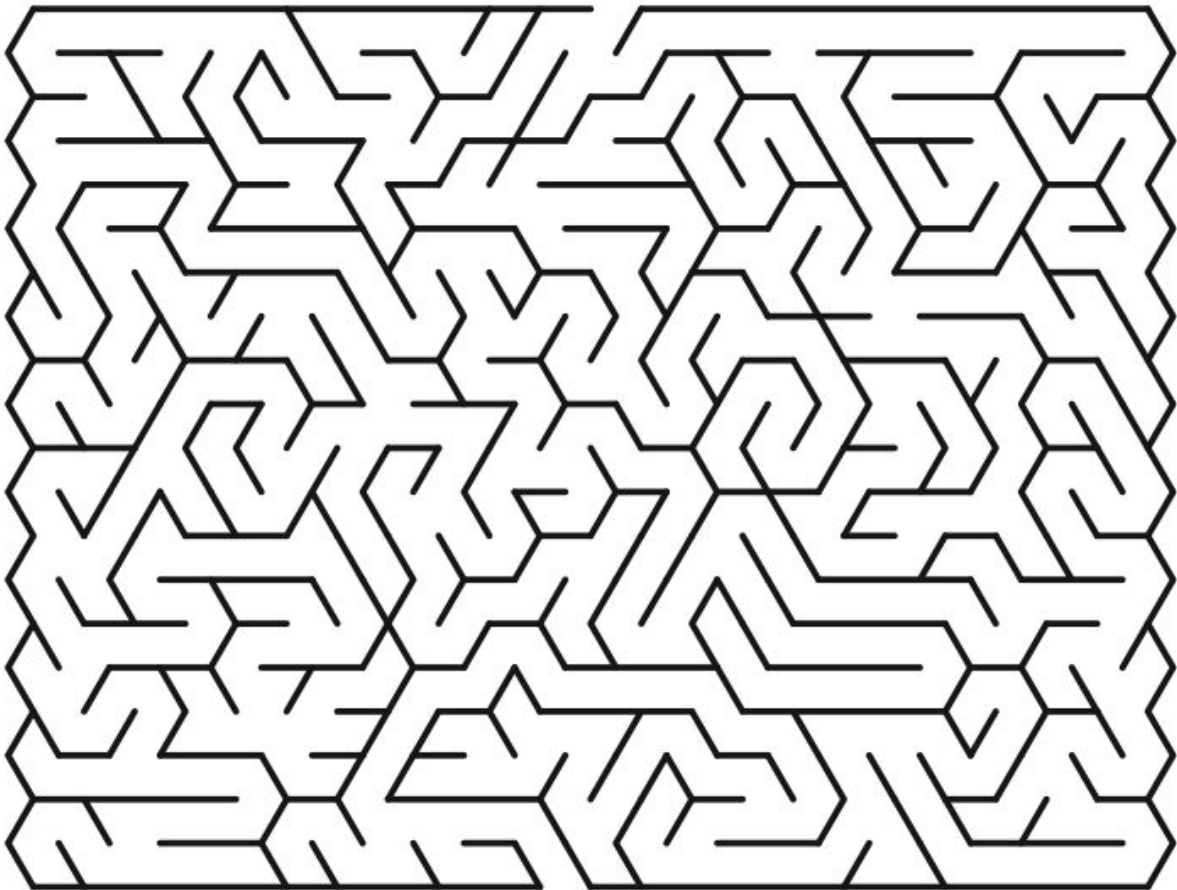
