arms to receive a blessing if you wish. A gluten-free wafer is
available. Holy Communion will be distributed in both kinds:
distribution of the wafer by the priest from the paten to be*

followed by receiving wine from the Lay Eucharistic Minister's common Communion chalice. Intinction (by dipping one's own wafer and hand into the cup) will not be offered. HOWEVER, distribution of the single serve kits (container with wafer and wine) will continue. The communicant can choose to only drink wine from the single-serve kit while leaving the host in the container. Our altar guild will reverently and properly dispose of the uneaten wafer. The communicant will consume the wafer and wine at the altar rail, and when returning to their pew an usher will be at the bottom of the stairs to collect the empty container and napkin.
